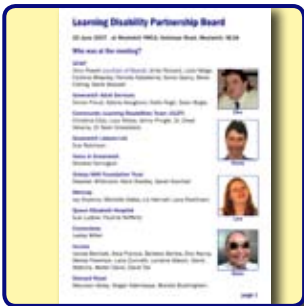

Paul Martindil gave the Board a presentation in September. He would like to keep the Board updated.

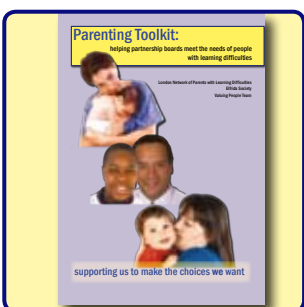

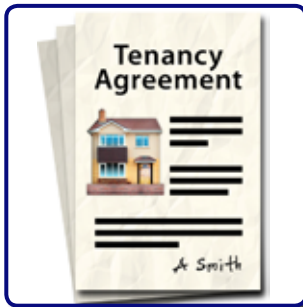
Parenting Toolkit

Ambulance service
