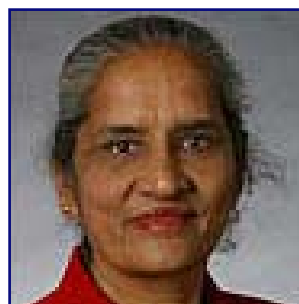

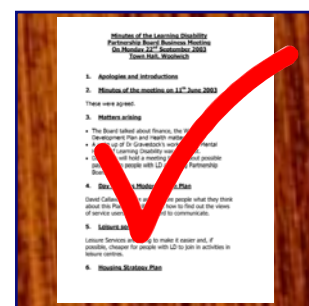

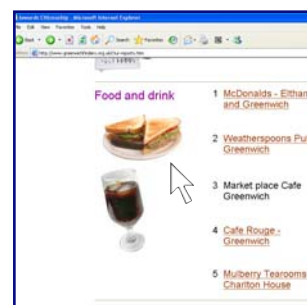
Working in Partnerships

After talking about how to make minutes and papers easier, the meeting looked at agendas and minutes by **Working with Words** and **Mencap**. Ideas were:

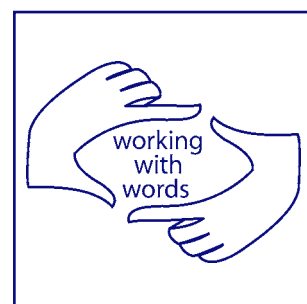
- Ask Day and Residential services to get more feedback.

- Information could be sent to **day services**.

6 Open Session

Ajibola Awogboro asked how people with learning disabilities could help make decisions.

These ideas came up about how to involve people:

- The role of people in charge of groups such as **Person Centred Planning**.
- Look at groups and champions and how they make decisions.



- **More people with learning disabilities** should be asked to come to the business meeting.
- **Leon Yohai** who talked at the last meeting could do a workshop.
- Workshops should use things like **flipcharts** with feedback.
- We should have a **Record of workshops** so we don't have to go over the same issues.
- A workshop **outside** of the Partnership Board so more service users could come to meetings.

BME groups
